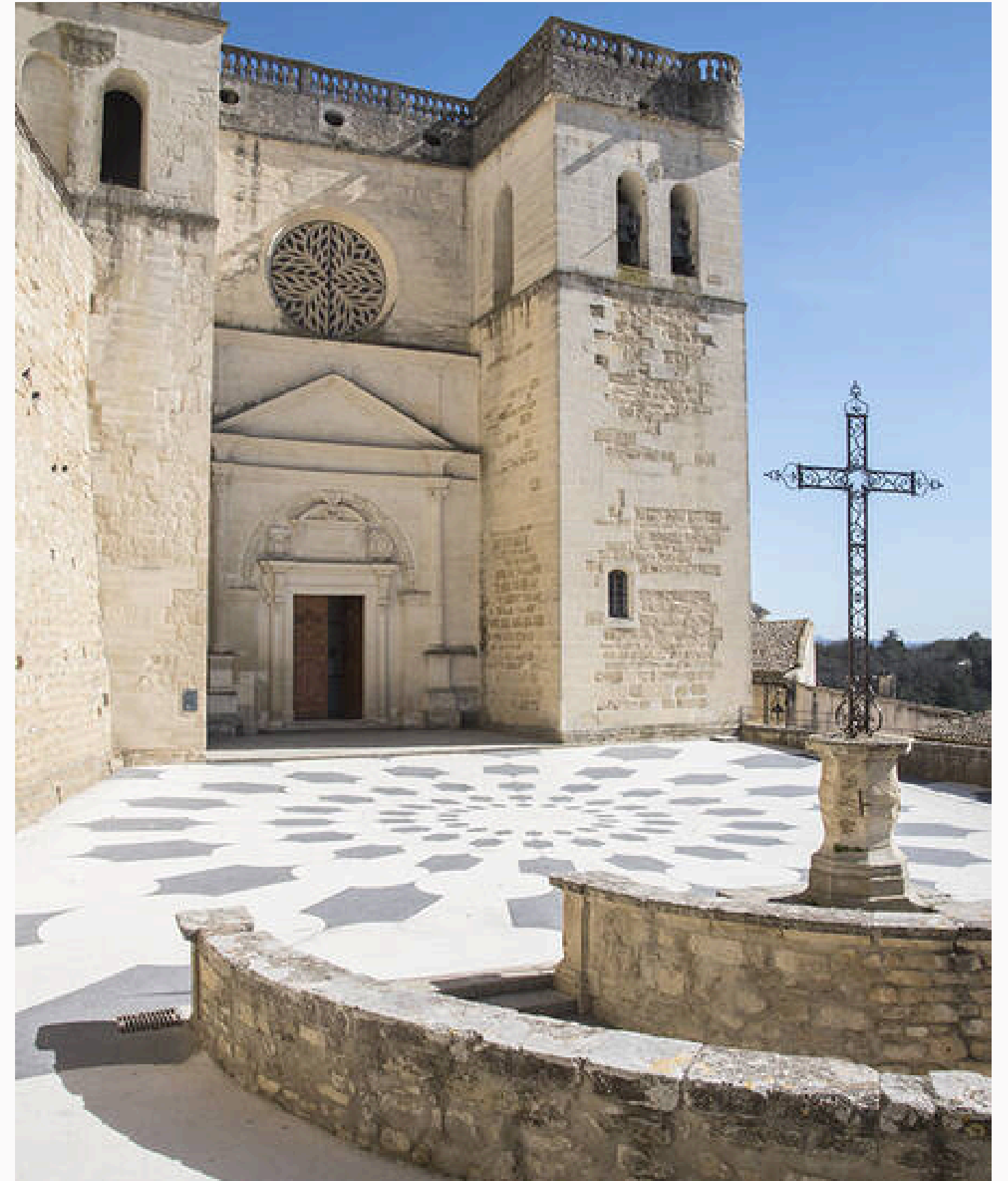

Built from 1535 to 1543 by Louis Adhémar de Monteil, lord of Grignan, it originally houses a college of canons. Madame de Sévigné was buried there in 1696. It welcomes in the Chapel of the Virgin a beautiful nativity scene at the end of the year.
