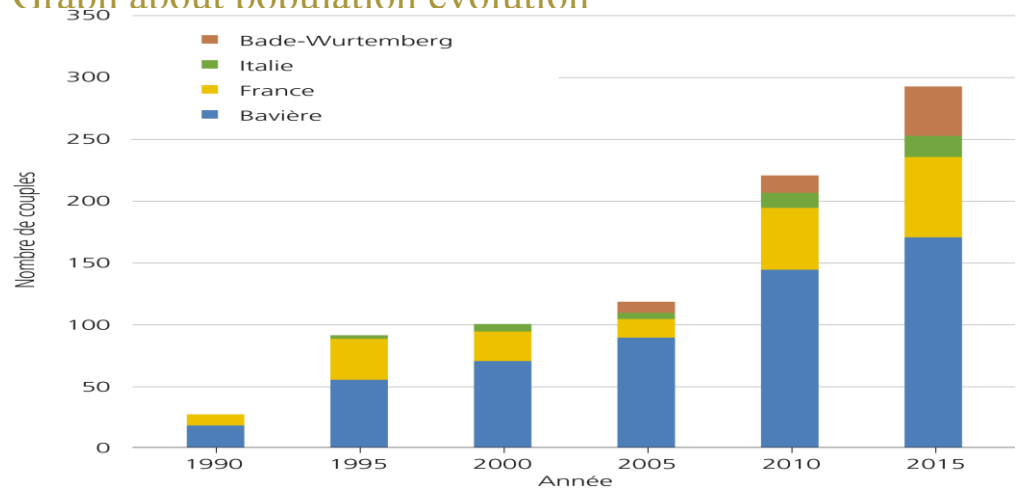

- We can notice that the population has multiplied in each of the 4 countries and especially in Baviere from 1990 to 2015.

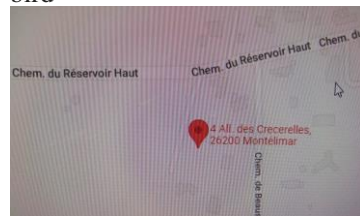
