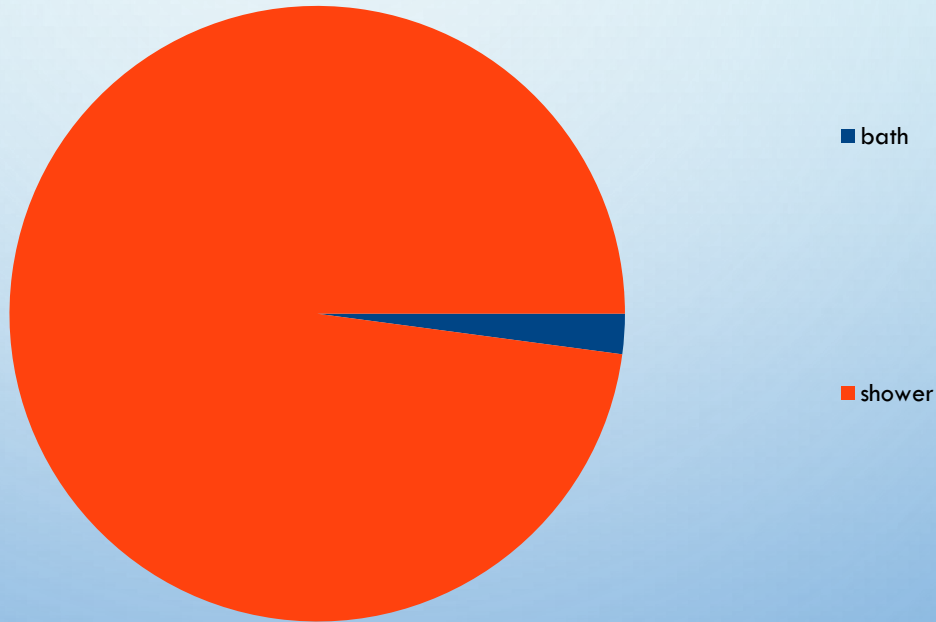

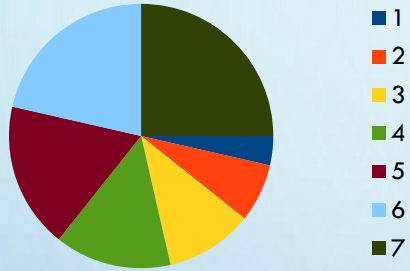

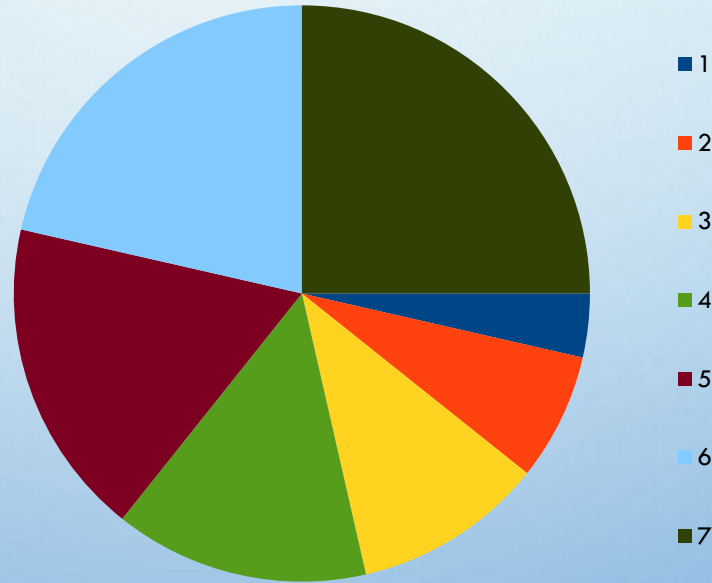
Question 2: Number of showers per week

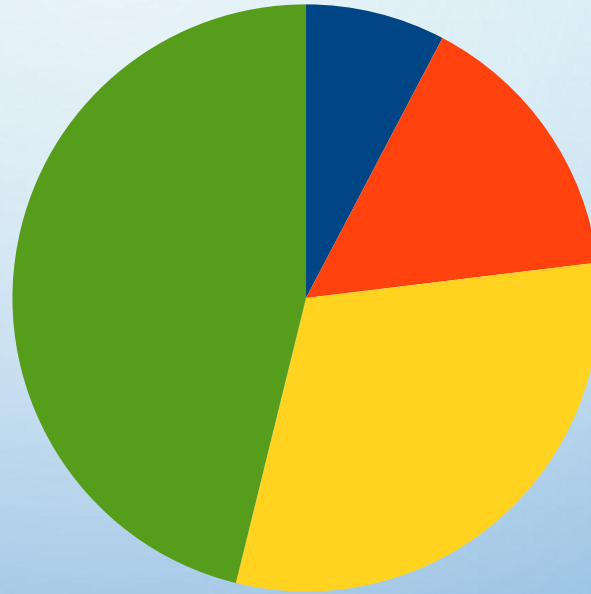

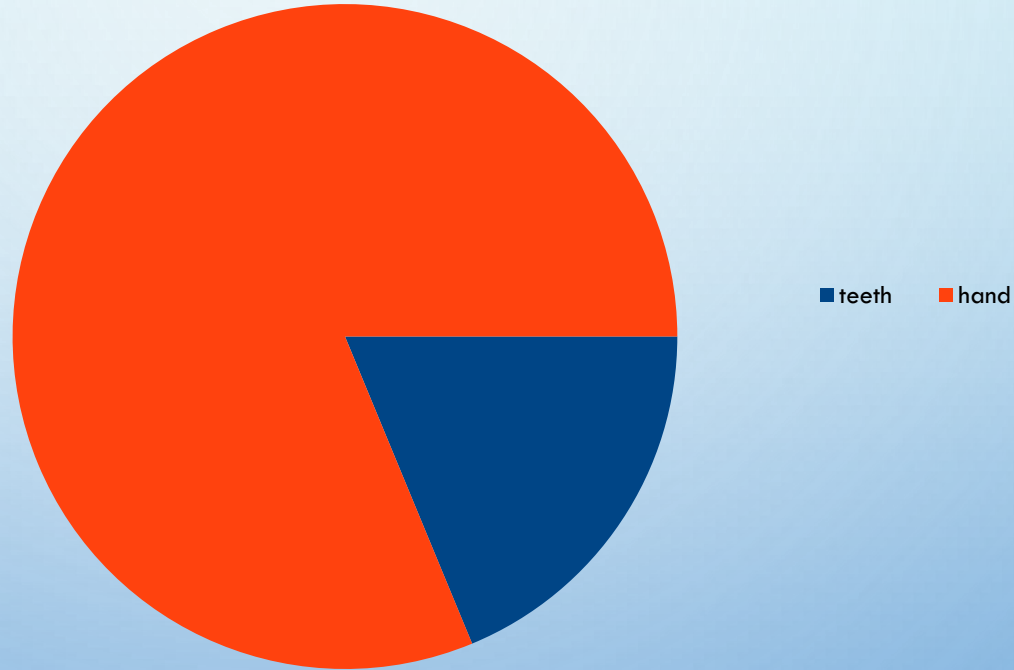

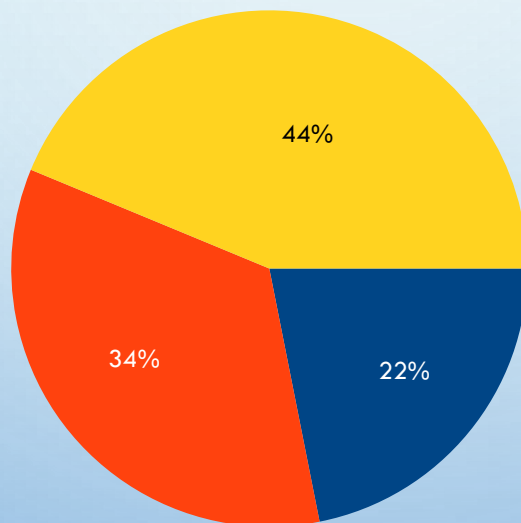

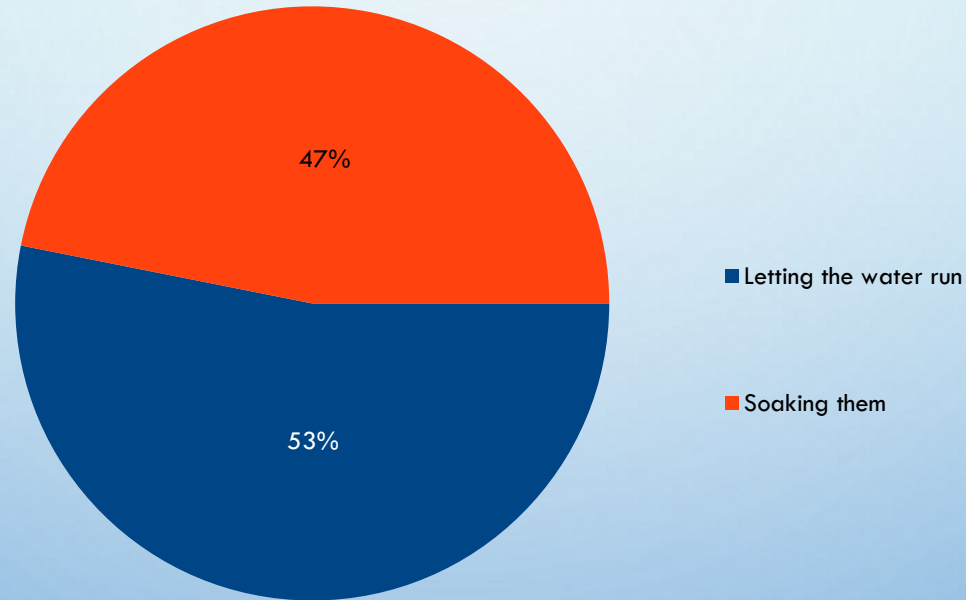

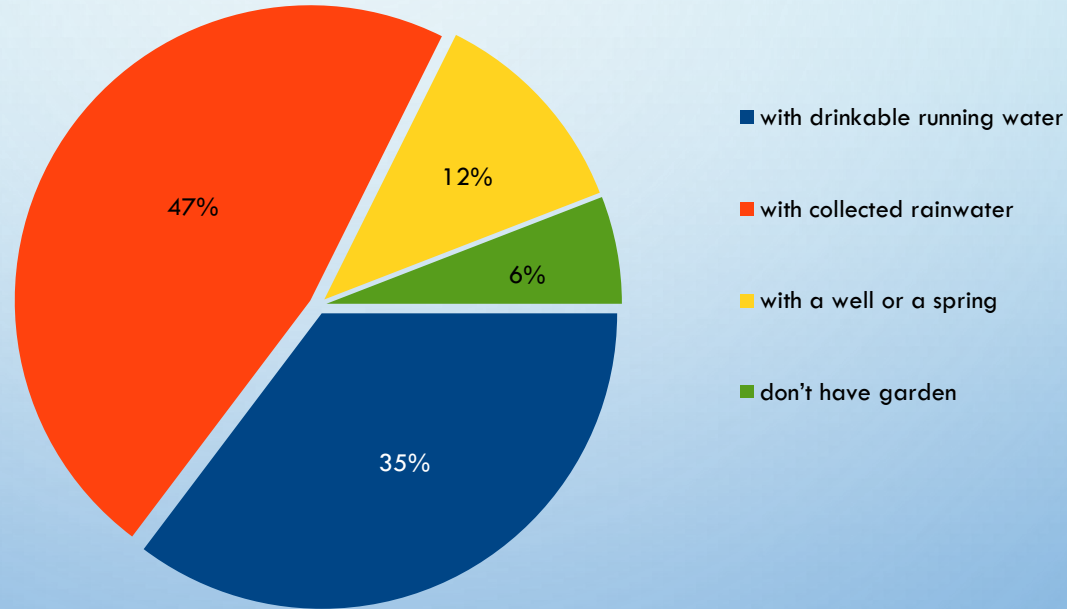

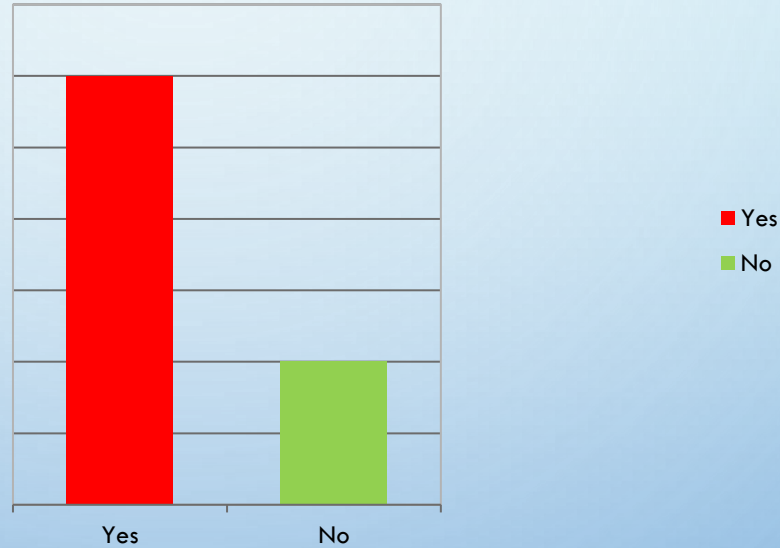

Question 9 : pool and pond

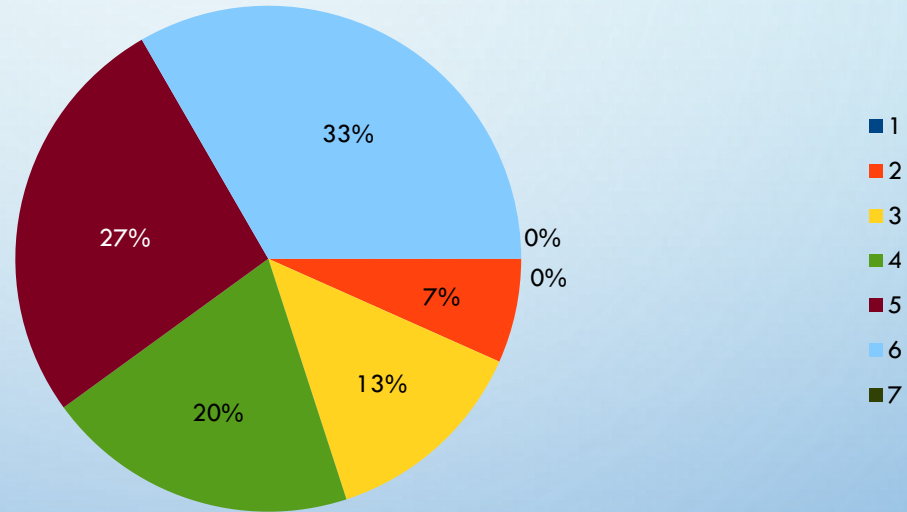
At home, we do regularly fill our pool or pond
